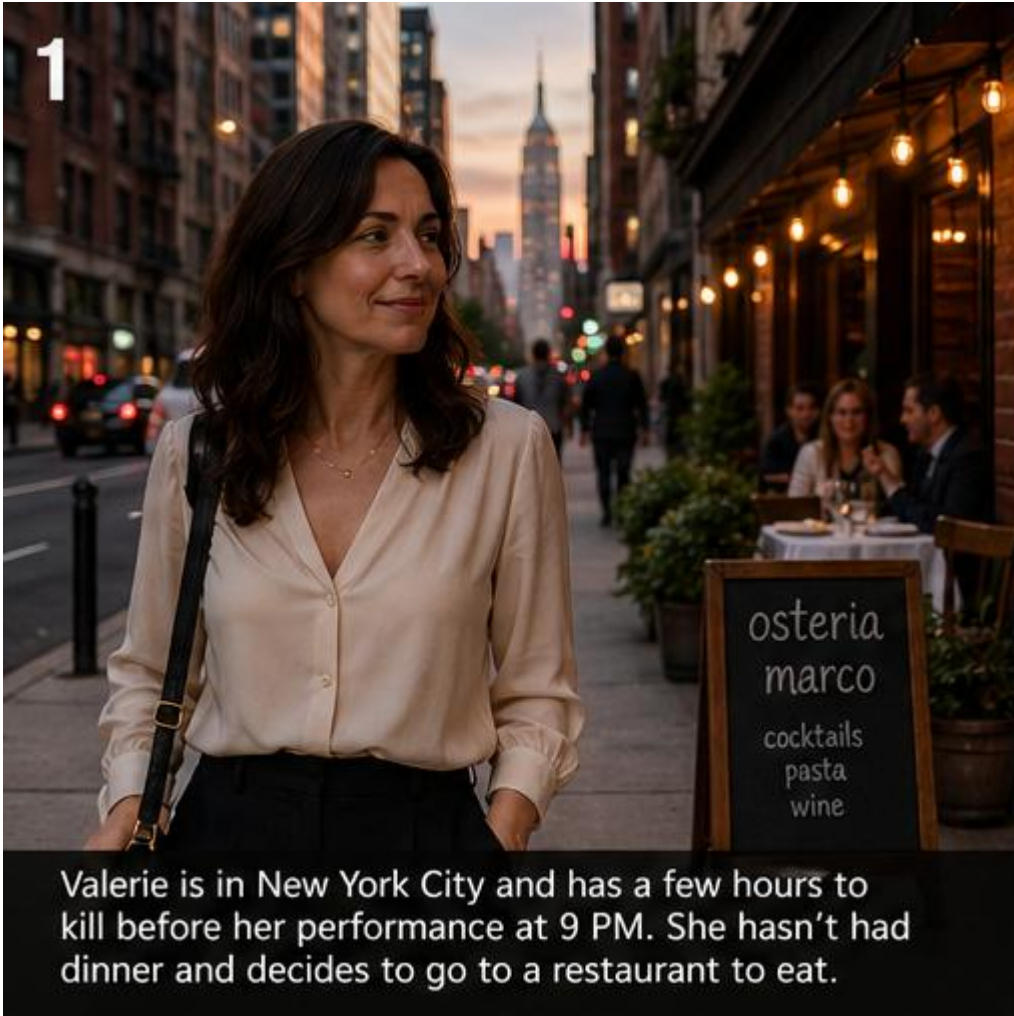


Storyboard 2

"I didn't realize how hungry I am. I think I'll go someplace nice for dinner."



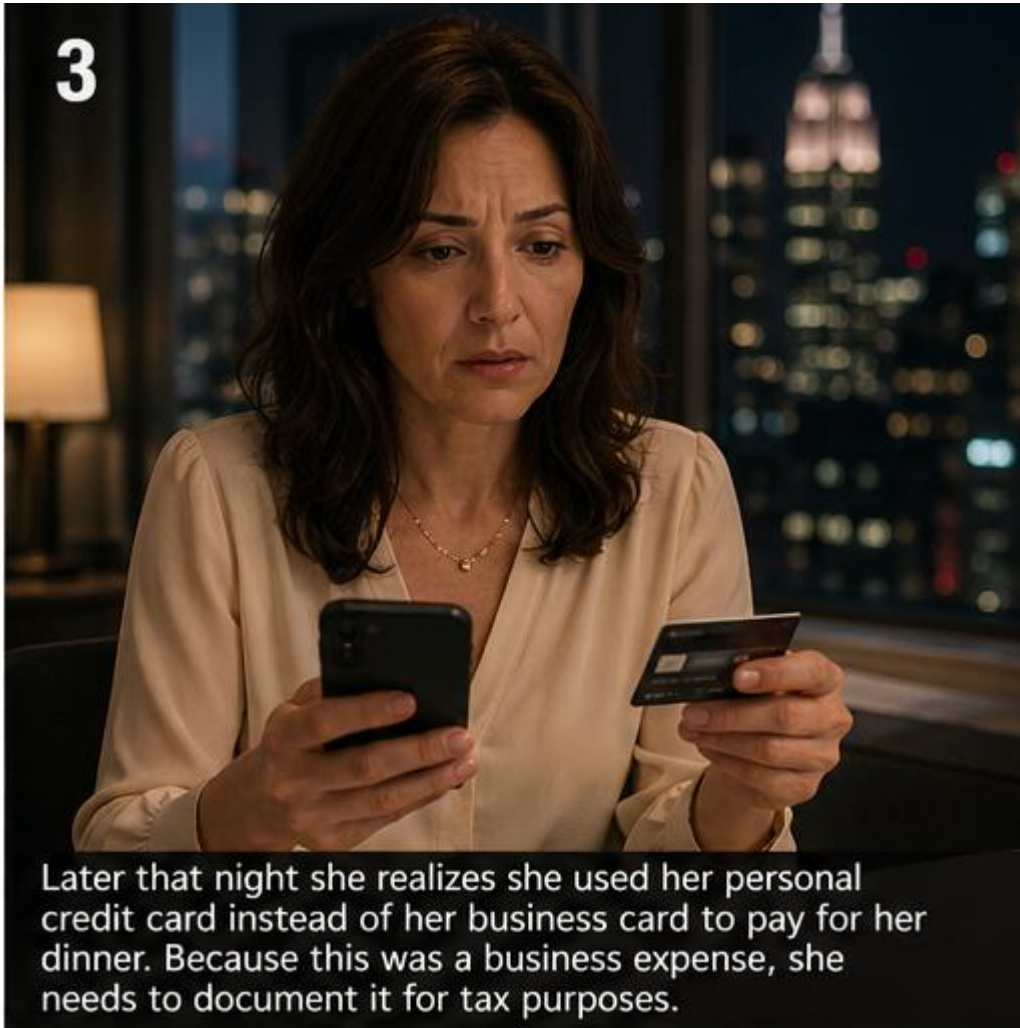
2. She pays for her meal with her credit card and leaves.

“Wow, that was great! I better get going so I don’t have to hurry to get ready for my performance tonight.”



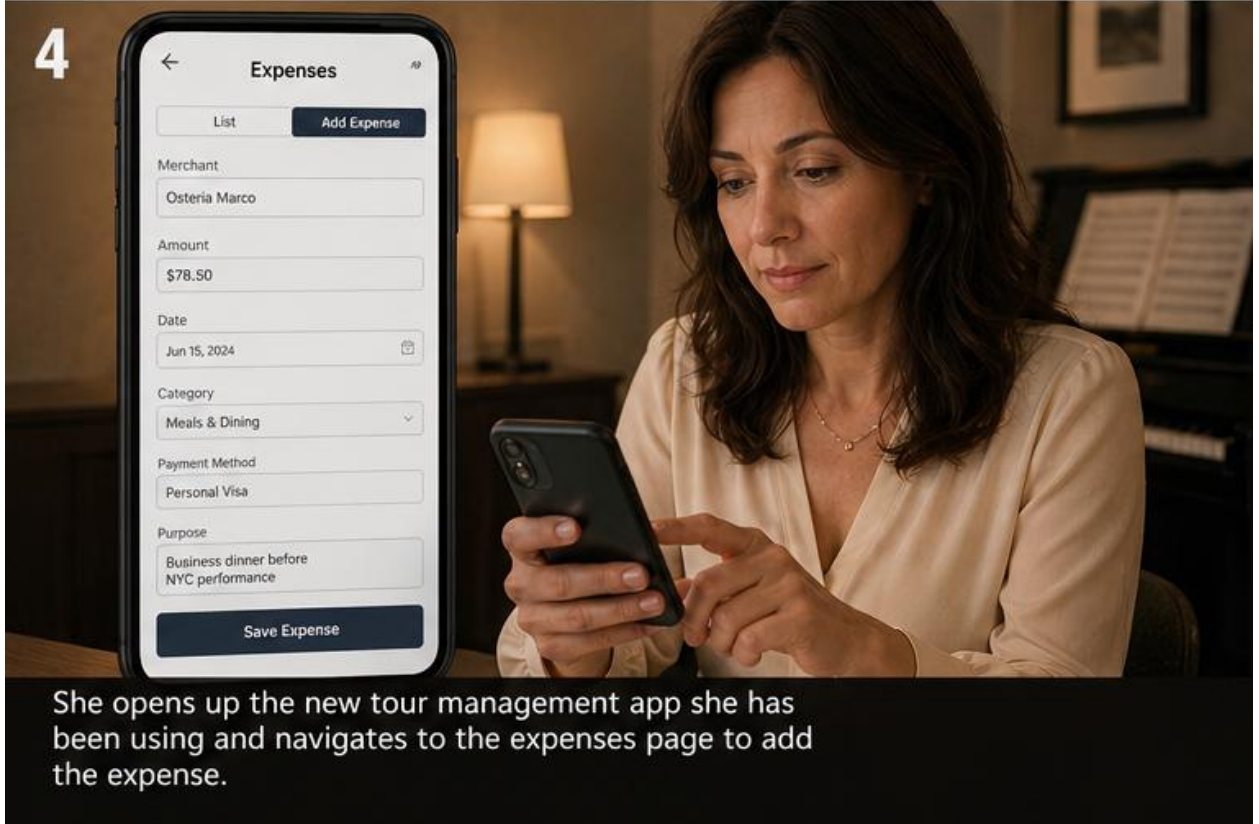
3. Later that night she realizes she used her personal credit card instead of her business card to pay for her dinner. Because this was a business expense, she needs to document it for tax purposes.

4. She opens up the new tour management app she has been using and navigates to the expenses page to add the expense.

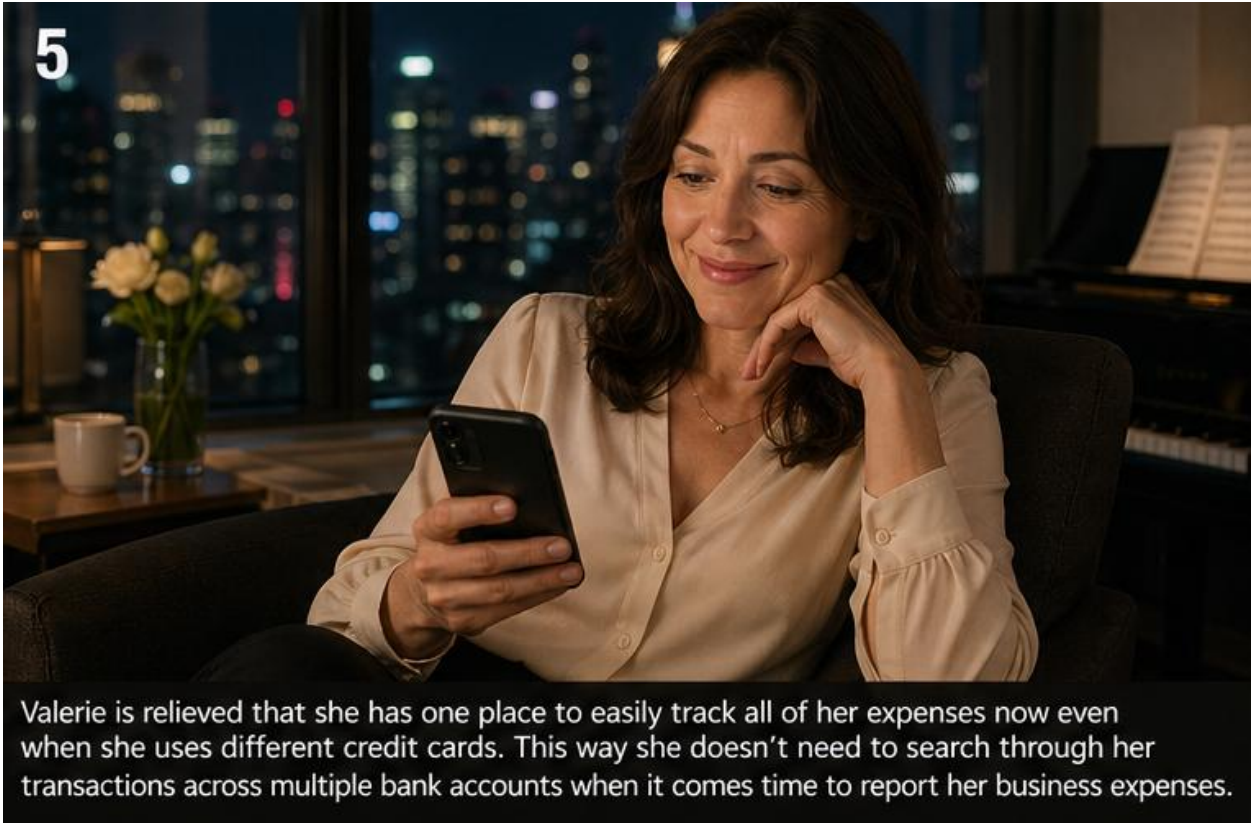
“Oh yeah, I have that new app! I think it has a place for me to track all my expenses while I’m on tour!”
