

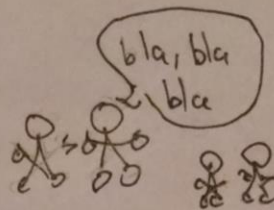
## Scenario 1

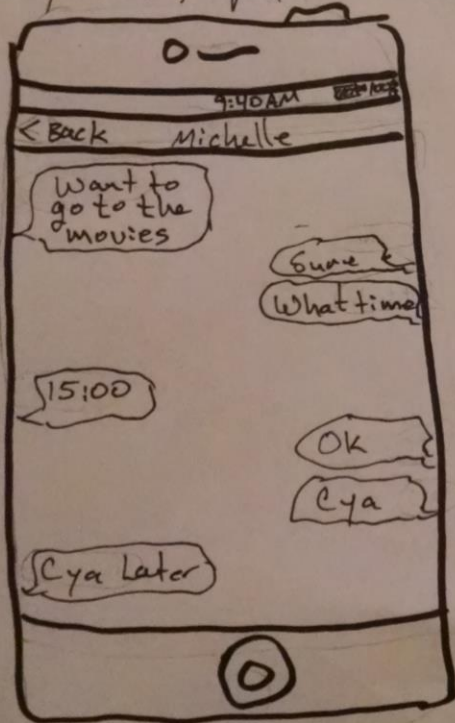
The children did not want to go to the reunion because it was mostly old people sitting around talking.



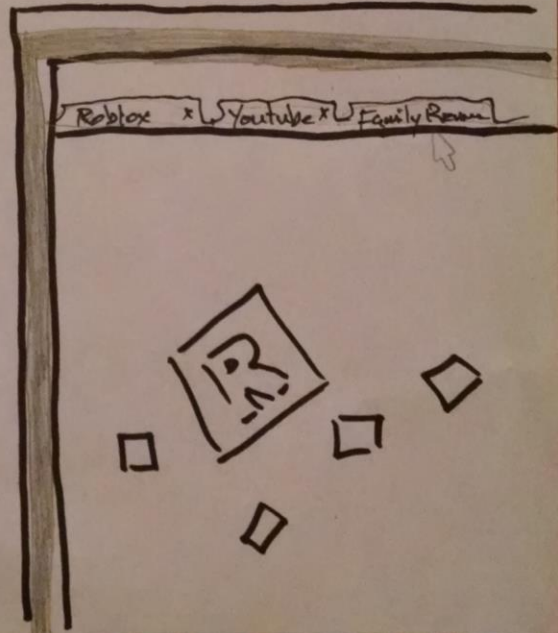
Earlier during the day, the children were making their own plans hoping their parents had forgotten the reunion. The parents had told Timmy about the internet site describing the reunion, boring.



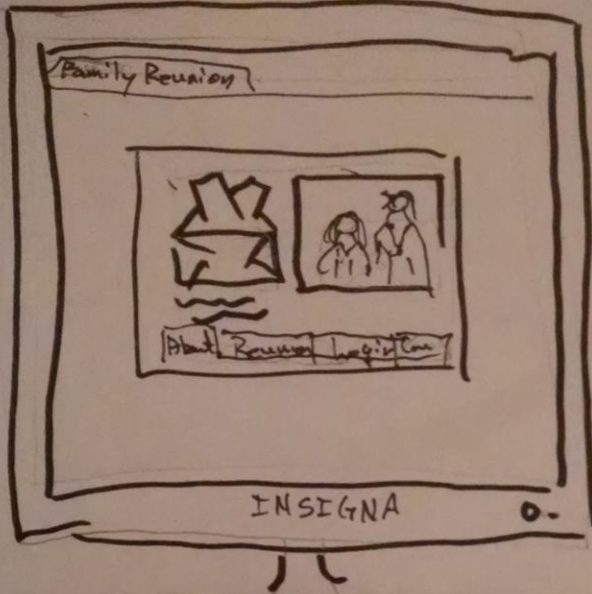
Timmy had forgotten the reunion



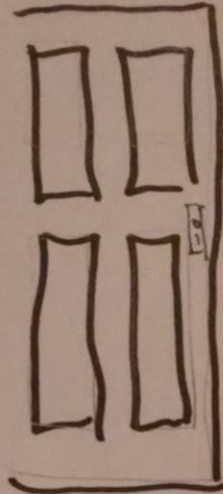
Hmm... I wonder about that site now and dad were telling me.
